New Criteria for Membership

According to the Aero Services Credit Union Co-operative Society Limited (ASCU) By-Laws, membership shall be open to all persons of good character, residents, occupying land or carrying on business in Trinidad and Tobago who are:

- Permanent and former employees of Trinidad and Tobago (BWIA International) Airways, Caribbean Airlines Limited; and their majority-owned subsidiaries and successor companies.
- Non-permanent employees of Trinidad and Tobago (BWIA International) Airways, Caribbean Airlines Limited, their majority-owned subsidiaries, and successor companies with a contract of not less than one (1) year.
- Permanent employees of the Society.
- Permanent employees of industries directly involved in the aviation business as identified by the Board of Directors from time to time.
- Employees from other organizations where remittances to the Society are transacted utilizing a payment system as the Board of Directors sees fit.
- Any person eligible for membership based on criteria agreed upon by the Board of Directors from time to time such as:
 - Members of Aero-Sponsored Sporting Bodies and Associations.
 - Businesspersons (owning registered businesses) and organizations (operating for at least four (4) years, including their employees, within the ASCU catchment area (i.e. Tunapuna, Trincity, Arouca, Piarco, and environs).
 - Self-employed persons engaged in business as a sole trader or as a registered business (for at least four (4) years).

- Students of schools in the ASCU catchment area.
- Persons with relevant experience in their field and fall into one (1) of the following categories:
 - Professionals in a specialist field (e.g. doctors, lawyers, accountants) and who are members of a registered professional organization (i.e. a body recognized by an Act of Parliament such as the Medical Board, Law Association, Institute of Chartered Accountants, Board of Engineering or Architecture, etc.) or have their own registered practice.
 - Designers, Artists.
 - Middle Managers.
 - Senior Managers.
 - Persons pursuing studies at an accredited University or tertiary institution towards the acquisition of a professional degree, or graduates of an accredited University or tertiary institution with a minimum of an undergraduate degree.
- Children, legitimate family members, and relatives.
- Members of other registered cooperative societies in Trinidad and Tobago.

Membership commences from the BOD approval date upon:

- The provision of documentation and information as required under local AML/CFT/CPF legislation regulations and guidelines.
- Purchase of shares valued at one dollar (\$1).
- Payment of a non-refundable processing fee determined by the BOD.
